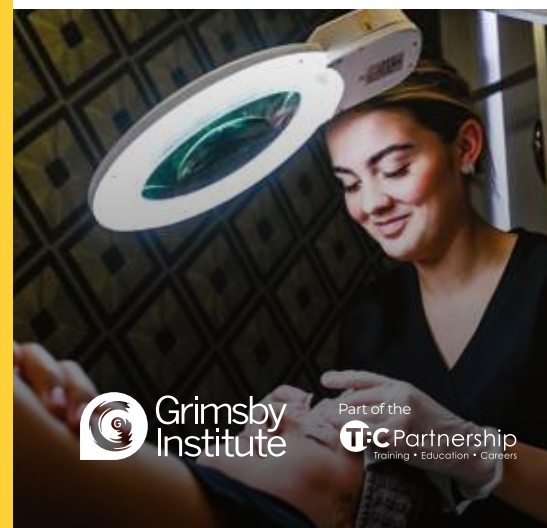

SUCCESS COACHES

Your welfare is our top priority, so when you enrol, you'll be allocated a Success Coach. This coach is assigned to you all year and will help you in areas such as attendance, achievement and progression.

Success Coaches provide a programme of individual coaching, which means they'll get to know your needs and in turn be able to help you throughout your time with us. Success Coaches provide a support system for each student, which is great for your personal development and helping you overcome any barriers to learning.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT – BURSARY

Many students need some financial help while studying and here at GI there are options to support you, depending on your personal circumstances.

This support might be able to help with course costs for supplies, travel, meals at College, childcare and other study-related expenses. There is increased financial support for young people who are from vulnerable groups, specifically those in care, care leavers and young people in receipt of income support or universal credit, subject to eligibility. There is also support for those in receipt of both Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments, in their own right as well as Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit in their own right.

SAFEGUARDING

To look after all the students and staff here at GI there is an Intensive Support Team, who are available to talk to if you have any concerns, are unhappy, or even worried about the welfare of a friend or a fellow student.

The team are here to chat things through and are very easy to approach. You can talk to one of them about problems you might be having, which might include being bullied, abuse, self-harm, accommodation issues, caring responsibilities, and anything else that you may be concerned about.

SPORTS CENTRE

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry requirements for our courses depend on the specific requirements of each Programme of Study and an individual's previous experience, which will all be discussed during the interview process.

The following list offers a guide as to what you might be expected to achieve to gain entry on to a particular level of a course.

PLEASE NOTE: IN SOME AREAS WHERE THERE IS A HIGHER MATHS, ENGLISH OR SCIENCE CONTENT, OR WHERE TECHNICAL SKILLS ARE REQUIRED, THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS ARE HIGHER THAN STATED BELOW. APPLICANTS ARE ADVISED OF ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDIVIDUAL COURSES AT THEIR INTERVIEW AND THIS IS CHECKED AT ENROLMENT. FOR CREATIVE COURSES A PORTFOLIO REVIEW OR AUDITION MAY BE REQUIRED AT INTERVIEW.

ENTRY LEVEL 3 PROGRAMMES

No formal entry qualifications but subject to approval from the Foundation Learning Assessment Team.

LEVEL 1 PROGRAMMES

GCSEs grades 1-2 or E to G or equivalent, including Foundation Awards and Entry Level Certificates.

LEVEL 2 PROGRAMMES

Minimum of 4 GCSEs grade 3 (previously D) or above including maths and English language OR Minimum of 4 GCSEs grade 3 or above including maths and English language and relevant subject qualification OR minimum of Level 1 course in chosen subject at merit or above and English language and maths at Level 1.

LEVEL 3 PROGRAMMES

Minimum of 5 GCSEs grade 4 (previously C) or above including maths and English language OR minimum of 5 GCSEs grade 4 or above including maths and English language and relevant subject qualification OR minimum of Level 2 course in chosen subject at merit or above and English language and maths at level 2.

PROGRESSING TO EACH LEVEL OF STUDY

Once you have successfully completed your course you may be able to progress to the next level, following a satisfactory interview with a Tutor. If you've finished your Level 3 course you will be offered advice and guidance from our Career Advisers on how to apply for a place at University through UCAS, or how to apply for a job or an Apprenticeship.

Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 courses generally last one year; Level 3 courses will usually last for two years.

In order to do an apprenticeship, you need an employer as well as a training provider or college. You can apply for a current apprenticeship in the following ways:

CAREER 6



WHAT IS CAREER 6?

Career 6 is a combination of A Levels and vocational study.

This is great if you want to combine hands-on courses with more theory-based subjects. The pathways are carefully designed to make sure that after qualifying, you'll be a great candidate for university or employment in your chosen field. We support your progression through related enrichment activities to universities and industry along with the opportunity for national and international visits that link to your pathway.

The two-year study programmes include tutorials, project work, enrichment sessions, leadership tasks, career-focused visits and trips, as well as work experience.

In the second year, students take an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) to support their progression into higher education. For all pathways, students must have a minimum of 5 GCSEs at Level 4 (C) or above including English and maths.

THE NEXT LEVEL QUALIFICATION

WHAT ARE T LEVELS?

T Levels are qualifications designed to give you a head start towards the future you want.

They follow GCSEs and are equivalent to three A Levels. The two-year qualification brings classroom and work placement together, on a course designed in collaboration with the best employers.

You'll spend 80% of your time in the classroom and 20% on a 45-day placement to equip you with the knowledge and skills companies are looking for. Your T Level will help you to step straight into your chosen career, an apprenticeship or a degree. Wherever your future is heading, take it to the next level.

We are the only college in North East Lincolnshire offering T Levels, which are available in:

- **Building Services Engineering for Construction**
- **Digital Production, Design & Development**
- **Education & Childcare**
- **Health**
- **Maintenance Engineering Technologies**
- **Manufacturing Technologies**
- **Onsite Construction**

T LEVEL EDUCATION & CHILDCARE

This course is suitable for anyone wanting a career in early years education, teaching, childcare or assisting teaching.

You can progress into roles such as nursery worker, special educational needs teaching assistant, teaching assistant or learning mentor or go onto university to become a teacher. During the two-year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in early years education, childcare and teaching. A substantial industry placement with a range of childcare employers will give you a wide understanding across the age ranges.

The T Level in Education and Childcare will include:

- Overview of childcare and education 0-19
- Child development
- Supporting education
- Safeguarding, health and safety and wellbeing
- Behaviour
- Observation and assessment
- Equality and diversity
- Special educational needs and disability
- English as an additional language
- Parents, families and carers
- Working with others
- Reflective practice.

The core content is assessed through an exam and a practical employer-set project. In addition to this, you will have the option to study one of the following specialisms:

- Early years education and childcare
- Supporting and mentoring students in further and higher education.

T LEVEL DIGITAL PRODUCTION, DESIGN & DEVELOPMENT

This is a two-year qualification which will include core content and an occupational specialism content that is specific to the industry.

One of the great things about this course is that you will work directly with employers and spend 20% of the course in a work environment. By the end of the course, you will have a portfolio of work at a professional standard.

This course is suitable for anyone wanting a career in software production and design. Students can progress into roles such as web developer, web designer, IT business analyst, app developer or digital marketer.

The core component of study provides a broad understanding of the digital industry and covers the following digital related topics:

- Problem solving
- Programming
- Emerging issues and impact of digital
- IT-related legislation
- Business context
- Data
- Digital environments (networking and PC builds)
- Cyber security
- Testing.

The occupational specialism content will allow you to develop the relevant skills in preparation for your career in the digital industry. The occupational specialism is assessed through an industry-standard software development project based on a provided client brief.

Throughout the occupational specialism you will learn how to do the following:

- Propose solutions by defining requirements and acceptance criteria aligned to user needs
- Design interfaces, data storage and algorithms required for a proposed solution
- Develop complete bespoke systems to meet business needs using a multitude of programming languages including HTML, CSS, JavaScript, PHP and SQL.
- Gather user feedback to inform a written evaluation of the project
- A substantial industry placement with a range of employers within the creative industry will build on your skills and technical knowledge.

T LEVEL HEALTH

This exciting T Level in Health will give you the essential knowledge and skills to work in health or science.

This includes; how the industry works, core scientific concepts and key regulations including managing information, health and safety and good scientific/clinical practice.

In your second year, you will focus on Adult Nursing Care.

T LEVEL ONSITE CONSTRUCTION

This T Level in Onsite Construction is suitable for anyone looking to start a career in the construction industry.

Following this T Level, you could progress straight into a skilled profession or continue your studies with a degree or higher apprenticeship. Career options might include becoming an advanced site carpenter or joiner, or a construction assembly and installation operative.

During the two-year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in construction. A substantial industry placement with a range of employers will give you a wide understanding of life on a construction site.

THE T LEVEL IN ONSITE CONSTRUCTION WILL INCLUDE:

- Design principles
- Project management
- Health and safety
- Commercial construction
- Stakeholder management
- Business structures
- Entrepreneurship
- Digital technology
- Innovation
- Sustainability.

The core content is assessed through an exam and a practical employer-set project. This knowledge will provide students with a greater understanding of the industry and will promote career progression. In addition to this, you will have the option to study one of the following specialisms:

- Carpentry and Joinery
- Bricklaying

The specialisms will focus more on the practical application of skills.

Additionally, you will undertake the CSCS card scheme, to support your development within the workplace

T LEVEL MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGIES

The Manufacturing Technologies T Level is suitable for anyone wanting a career in manufacturing.

During the two-year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in manufacturing. A substantial industry placement with a range of employers will give you a wide understanding of the industry.

The technical qualification is made up of two components, all of which need to be successfully achieved to attain the technical qualification as well as the full T Level Technical Qualification in Engineering, Manufacturing, Processing and Control (Level 3).

Core content has been designed to give sufficient knowledge and skills for you to apply in a variety of contexts related to the engineering industry and the occupational specialisms linked to this T Level.

The common core content is the building blocks of knowledge and skills that will give you a broad understanding of the industry and job roles. At the same time, it will develop the core skills you will need to apply when working within the industry.

The occupational specialism component (Fabrication & Welding) will develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours necessary to achieve threshold competence in an occupation. Threshold competence is defined as when a student's attainment against the knowledge, skills and behaviours is of a standard for them to enter the occupation and industry. They must also demonstrate the ability to achieve occupational competence over time with the correct support and training. The core content is assessed through an exam and a practical employer-set project.

T LEVEL MAINTENANCE ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGIES

The Maintenance Engineering Technologies T Level is suitable for anyone wanting a career in engineering and manufacturing.

This qualification will include a core content and an occupational specialism that is specific to the industry.

During the two-year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in engineering. A substantial industry placement with a range of employers will give you a wide understanding of the industry.

The technical qualification is made up of two components, all of which need to be successfully achieved to attain the technical qualification as well as the full T Level Technical Qualification in Maintenance, Installation and Repair for Engineering and Manufacturing (Level 3).

The common core content is the building blocks of knowledge and skills that will give you a broad understanding of the industry and job roles. At the same time, it will develop the core skills you will need to apply when working within the industry.

An Occupational Specialism component (Mechanical, Mechatronic or Light & Electric Vehicles) which will develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours necessary to achieve threshold competence in an occupation. You will also need to demonstrate the ability to achieve occupational competence over time with the correct support and training.

The core content is assessed through an exam and a practical employer-set project.

T LEVEL BUILDING SERVICES ENGINEERING FOR CONSTRUCTION ELECTROTECHNICAL ENGINEERING

This exciting new T Level is suitable for anyone wanting a career in construction, specifically in areas such as electric installation and maintenance, plumbing or heating.

In addition to the core content, you will have the opportunity to study in one of the following occupational specialisms:

ELECTROTECHNICAL ENGINEERING:

This pathway will give you the skills and knowledge to enable you to undertake fundamental electrotechnical systems engineering processes and procedures. You will have the opportunity to plan, perform and evaluate their work while using a range of materials, methods and techniques.

You will develop their knowledge, understanding and skills in:

- Health and safety practices associated with carrying out electrotechnical systems engineering
- Installation methods and termination of connections
- Systems and products used in electrotechnical engineering
- Analysing and using information to and from electrotechnical systems
- Removal processes as part of system decommissioning.

REFRIGERATION ENGINEERING AND AIRCON ENGINEERING:

This pathway will give you the option to learn about and undertake fundamental refrigeration and air conditioning work. You will have the opportunity to plan, perform and evaluate your work while utilising a range of materials, methods and techniques.

You will develop their knowledge and understanding of, and skills in:

- Installing, commissioning and maintaining refrigeration and air conditioning systems
- The hazards, health and safety and environmental requirements when working on a refrigeration and/or air conditioning system
- Identifying and selecting the correct tools and equipment for a specific task
- Fabricating pipework and pressure testing a refrigeration system to ensure it is leak-free
- Fault-finding mechanical and electrical problems in refrigeration and air conditioning systems.





FOUNDATIONS

The foundation programmes at College enable you to settle into College life. It introduces our ways of working, IT systems and timetables and allows you to become familiar in the new environment at your own pace. This enables you to become more confident and relaxed within a new educational setting.

Group sizes are small, and support is focused on preparation for the future.

Our pathways year 1 programme is designed around six projects, maths and English, with the sole aim of developing and improving independence skills, life skills, travel training, communication, teamwork, self-management and personal care. Ambition, future plans and targets are also explored and developed within this programme. This includes developing links with other providers and participating in external challenges and events within the local community.

Independence skills are practical sessions held in a bespoke house on College grounds, which has a working kitchen, laundry room, bedroom, bathroom and lounge.

Healthy eating, exercise and fitness are actively promoted through all sorts of sporting activities undertaken on a weekly basis, which are tailored to everyone's specific needs. Sports include basketball, boccia, table tennis and badminton as well as gym sessions within our sports centre. We also visit and use other sports facilities and leisure centres within the local community.

During the second year you will experience a variety of pathways at the Grimsby Institute and gain accredited and non-accredited qualifications. The pathways include media, health and social care, performing arts, automotive, hospitality, childcare and more, helping you to make further choices and options for your next steps.

Following two years of pathway foundations programmes, you will enter mainstream courses or continue onto the supported internship programme.

SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

The supported internship programme ensures that you have the right support to begin life as a professional in your chosen career. This is an ideal exit course for those looking for an opportunity to gain vital work experience within a range of vocational positions, with excellent future prospects.

You'll receive incredible job coach support while on a 260-hour work placement, with a personalised programme of learning which is tailored to suit your individual needs and career aspirations.

The course includes maths, English and ICT, as well as customer service, personal development and employability skills to prepare students for the work place. The supported internship programme helps you improve your skills and confidence so that you can go out and find regular paid or voluntary work.

**ANGLIAN WATER
ALLIANCES**

This pre-apprenticeship skills programme works in collaboration with Anglian Water and its Alliance partners, providing a fully employer-supported multi-skill construction course.

This programme has been designed with the specific aim of attracting new talent into the utility sector, enabling you to ultimately work for one of the Alliance's companies as apprentices.

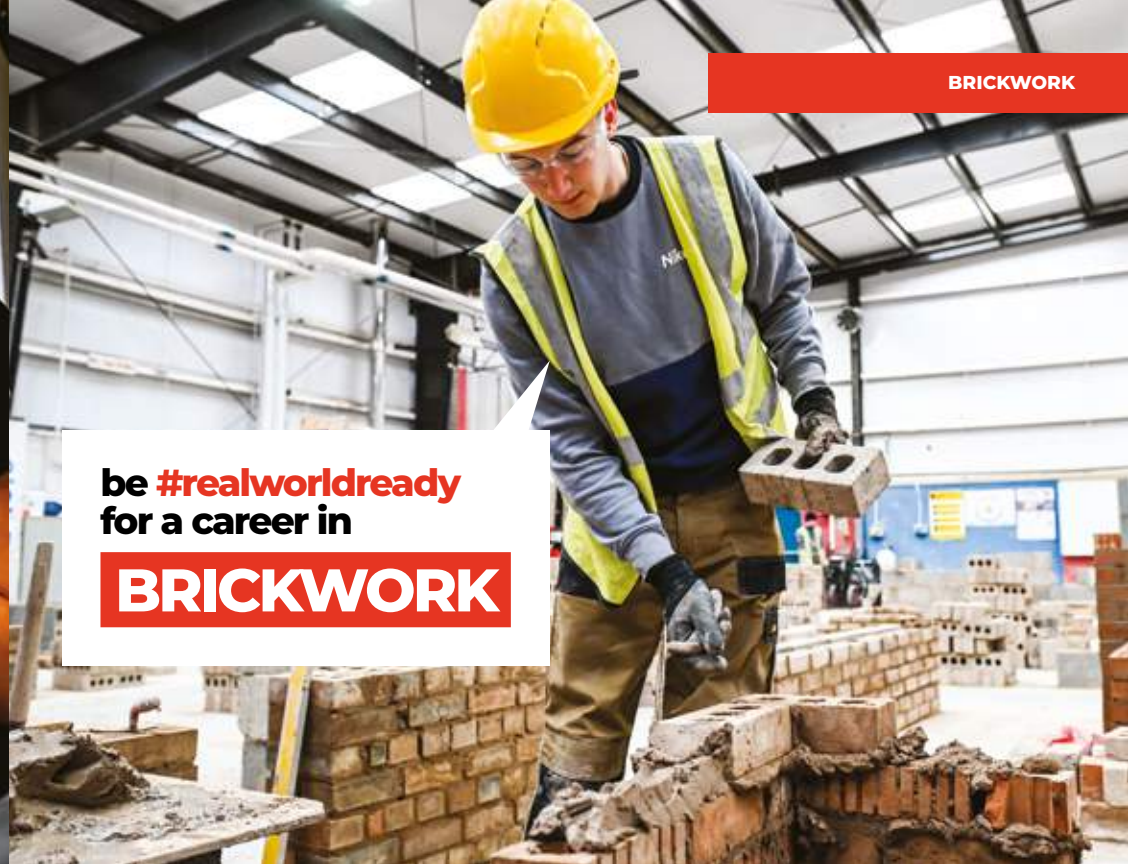

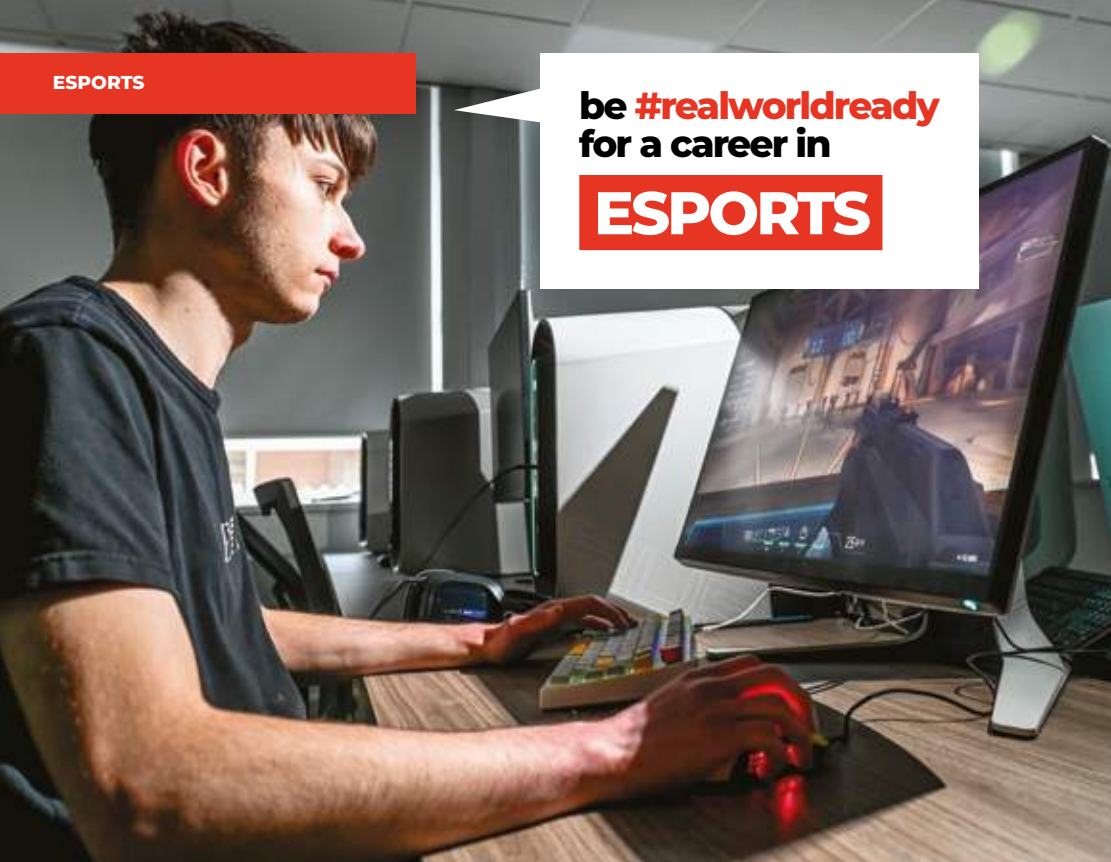
