NEW £5 MILLION ANIMAL CARE TEACHING FACILITY AND VETERINARY PRACTICE

OPENING SPRING 2025 AT NUNS CORNER

Grimsby Institute is well underway with constructing a new £5 million animal care teaching facility and veterinary practice at our Nuns Corner campus. Partnering with Topcon Building Ltd, this project aims to redefine animal care education and ensure students are Real World Ready.

The facility will feature modern teaching spaces, a fully operational veterinary practice, and areas designed for animal welfare, including outdoor enclosures and a dog-walking space. It will replace the outdated Nunsthorpe campus and house various animals, providing hands-on learning opportunities.

Topcon Building Ltd, a local contractor, is leading the construction, which is set for completion by Spring 2025. This development will equip students with essential skills for careers in animal care and veterinary services.

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Getting to Grimsby Institute is simple. T LEVELS



WHAT ARE T LEVELS?

T Levels are nationally recognised technical qualifications worth the same number of UCAS points as 3 A Levels. They tend to follow GCSEs, and are a two-year qualification bringing together classroom study and a work placement. Your T Level will help you step straight into your chosen career, apprenticeship or degree, having gained relevant knowledge and the skills and behaviours sought by employers.

T Levels provide more academic study than Apprenticeships. You will experience a mix of classroom and workplace based learning, spending 80% of your time at college and 20% of your time developing the skills needed for the workplace.

BACKED BY BUSINESS

A wide range of leading businesses of all sizes and across different industries helped to shape T Levels. They are now supported by employers to give you the workplace skills you need to succeed.

Many employers support progression of T Level students within their business, whether that's moving onto an apprenticeship or starting another role.

Combining classroom based learning and workplace experience, T Levels put students in a strong position when it comes to deciding on next steps by:

HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE

Apprenticeships provide practical, on-the-job training, allowing apprentices to gain valuable experience in a real work environment. This experience is highly valued by a wide range of employers.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

Apprenticeships offer structured training programmes that are designed to develop specific skills and knowledge relevant to the industry. This enables apprentices to acquire a wide range of industry approved skills, from technical expertise to enable success in the field, to invaluable personal and professional skills such as communication, teamwork and time management.

EARN WHILE YOU LEARN

Apprenticeships are paid positions, providing the opportunity to earn a salary while they learn. This can make apprenticeships an attractive option for individuals who want to avoid student debt while gaining valuable qualifications.

FOUNDATIONS

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The Foundation programme at Grimsby Institute enables you to settle into college life. It introduces our ways of working, IT systems and timetables and allows you to become familiar in the new environment at your own pace, enabling you to become more confident and relaxed within a new educational setting. Group sizes are small, and support is focused on preparation for your future.

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAMME INCLUDE?

Our pathways Year 1 programme is designed around six projects, maths and English, with the sole aim of developing and improving independence skills, life skills, travel training, communication, teamwork, self-management and personal care. Ambition, future plans and targets are also explored and developed within this programme. This includes developing links with other providers and participating in external challenges and events within the local community.





This exciting new T Level is suitable for anyone wanting a career in construction, specifically in areas such as electric installation and maintenance, plumbing or heating.

In addition to the core content, you will have the opportunity to study in one of the following occupational specialisms:

WHAT WILL I LEARN?

This pathway will give you the skills and knowledge to enable you to undertake fundamental electrotechnical systems, engineering processes and procedures. You will have the opportunity to plan, perform and evaluate your work while using a range of materials, methods and techniques.

You will develop their knowledge, understanding and skills in:

- Health and safety practices associated with carrying out electrotechnical systems engineering
- Installation methods and termination of connections
- Systems and products used in electrotechnical engineering
- Analysing and using information to and from electrotechnical systems
- Removal processes as part of system decommissioning.

REFRIGERATION ENGINEERING AND AIRCON ENGINEERING:

This pathway will give you the option to learn about and undertake fundamental refrigeration and air conditioning work. You will have the opportunity to plan, perform and evaluate your work while utilising a range of materials, methods and techniques.

By the end of the course, you will have a portfolio of work at a professional standard.



- Gather user feedback to inform a written evaluation of the project.





TLEVEL - EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE

This course is suitable for anyone wanting a career in early years education, teaching, childcare or assisting teaching.

You can progress into roles such as nursery worker, special educational needs teaching assistant, teaching assistant or learning mentor or go onto university to become a teacher. During the two year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in manufacturing. A substantial industry placement with a range of employers will give you a wide understanding of the industry.

The technical qualification is made up of two components, all of which need to be successfully achieved to attain the technical qualification as well as the full T Level Technical Qualification in Engineering, Manufacturing, Processing and Control (Level 3).

Core content has been designed to give sufficient knowledge and skills for you to apply in a variety of contexts related to the engineering industry and the occupational specialisms linked to this T Level.

The common core content is the building blocks of knowledge and skills that will give a you a broad understanding of the industry and job roles. At the same time, it will develop the core skills you will need to apply when working within the industry.

The occupational specialism component (Fabrication & Welding) will develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours necessary to achieve threshold competence in an occupation. Threshold competence is defined as when a student's attainment against the knowledge, skills and behaviours is of a standard for you to enter the occupation and industry. You must also demonstrate the ability to achieve occupational competence over time with the correct support and training. The core content is assessed through an exam and a practical employer set project.





T LEVEL - ONSITE CONSTRUCTION (BRICKWORK)



This T Level in Onsite Construction is suitable for anyone looking to start a career in the construction industry.

Following this T Level, you could progress straight into a skilled profession or continue your studies with a degree or higher apprenticeship. Career options might include becoming an advanced site carpenter or joiner, or a construction assembly and installation operative.

During the two-year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in construction. A substantial industry placement with a range of employers will give you a wide understanding of life on a construction site.

Additionally, you will undertake the CSCS card scheme, to support your development within the workplace.





T LEVEL – MAINTENANCE ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGIES

The Maintenance Engineering Technologies T Level is suitable for anyone wanting a career in engineering and manufacturing.

This qualification will include a core content and an occupational specialism that is specific to the industry.

During the two year course, you will learn the core knowledge and skills that underpin many jobs in engineering. A substantial industry placement with a range of employers will give you a wide understanding of the industry.

The technical qualification is made up of two components, all of which need to be successfully achieved to attain the technical qualification as well as the full T Level Technical Qualification in Maintenance, Installation and Repair for Engineering and Manufacturing.

The common core content is the building blocks of knowledge and skills that will give you a broad understanding of the industry and job roles. At the same time, it will develop the core skills you will need to apply when working within the industry.

An Occupational Specialism component (Mechanical, Mechatronic or Light & Electric Vehicles) which will develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours necessary to achieve threshold competence in an occupation. You will also need to demonstrate the ability to achieve occupational competence over time with the correct support and training.
