SUPPORT

If you think you need additional support with your studies, please contact us prior to starting your programme and we will offer all the advice and guidance you need.

We also offer screening for dyslexia, dyspraxia and scoptic sensitivity, which are hidden learning disabilities that can inhibit the progression of some students..

UCG has a facility for the visually impaired, located within the Learning Resource Centre, and staff are on hand to assist students. Students with disabilities are supported and given the opportunity to apply for the Disabled Students Allowance (DSA), which is a government fund administered by Student Finance England that can pay for specialist equipment or other kinds of support.

We are located in the heart of Grimsby. It's bursting with places to see and things to do.

JARGON BUSTER

As well as traditional three-year degrees, we also offer a range of other study options including: Foundation Degrees, Higher Nationals and Access to Higher Education, as well as part-time study options in a number of subjects.

BACHELOR'S DEGREE

A traditional degree programme runs from Levels 4 to 6 and takes three years to complete, after which you are awarded a degree qualification in your chosen subject. If you have completed a Level 5 qualification such as a foundation degree, you can progress onto a top up degree. This Level 6 programme runs for one year and is an alternative route to gaining a bachelor's degree.

At the University Centre Grimsby, our bachelor's degree programmes are either:

- · BA (Bachelor of Arts)
- BSc (Bachelor of Science)

If you see (Hons) after BA/BSc, you will graduate with honours, provided you meet the required academic standard. A bachelor's degree will broaden your horizons and employment prospects, with statistics showing that graduates have significantly higher rates of employment, and can earn on average £10,000 more than non-graduates.

MASTER'S DEGREE

This is a postgraduate degree and is studied after you have completed your bachelor's degree. It is designed for you to study an area of interest in more depth. You will study 180 credits made up of modules and a dissertation over one to two years full-time or two to four years part-time. Master's degrees can further improve your career prospects.

FOUNDATION DEGREE

A flexible, technical and professional qualification usually involving work-based studying, which typically takes two years to complete. These programmes are suitable for those looking to formalise their workplace knowledge with a qualification, or those wishing to enter a specific profession.

Graduates of Foundation degrees are able to undertake further study to achieve a BA or BSc degree.

These programmes take less time to complete and are often designed to prepare you for a specific career.

They are vocationally focused and therefore lead straight to work. They can also prepare you for a higher qualification.

HNC - HIGHER NATIONAL CERTIFICATE:

This is equivalent to the first year of a degree (Level 4). A full-time programme takes one year to complete, or two years for part-time.

HND - HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA:

This is equivalent to two years at university (Level 5). A full-time programme takes two years to complete, or four years part-time.

ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION:

The Access to Higher Education Diploma is a nationally recognised qualification by higher education institutions across the UK. This is an alternative route to enter university for adults.

CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION:

This is designed for those who aspire to work or are currently working in a role where they need to develop knowledge and skills in teaching, learning and assessment.

PROFESSIONAL GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION:

A professional programme which requires a degree-level qualification at Level 6, for those aspiring to work or those who are currently working in the life-long learning sector.
