Access to **Higher Education Diploma**

Level: Equivalent to Level 3 (A Level standard) **Duration:** 1 year full-time or 2 years part-time

Access to Higher Education (HE) is a nationally recognised qualification designed to prepare those who are 19+ for university-level study.

Level: 5

Duration: 2 years full-time or 3-4 years part-time
